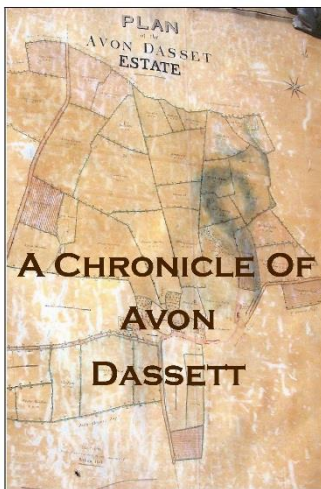

- **BOhisto – Bolzano-Bozen’s History Online** The minutes of the Municipal Council of Bozen-Bolzano have been digitised. From 1470 to the late 17th century, these records shed light on the administration, the economy and townspeople’s life in of one of the main urban centres of Tyrol. • **New community parish history published** The Avon Dasset Local History Group have recently published *A Chronicle of Avon Dasset*, a fully illustrated book resulting from a community history project funded by Stratford District Council.
